Air rifles are fun, safe and simple, making them the go-to tool to introduce youngsters and adults to the sport of target shooting. Target shooting is known as a life time sport and can be practiced for most at an early age through adult hood and can be practiced by many regardless of physical ability.

School Sets: \$3,000 - Teachers attending the training can apply for a school set at 50% matching (TPWD pays \$1,500 and School pays \$1,500). Full SAR School Set for HALF off - \$1,500. TPWD has a limited number of the school sets to offer.

Dove season is right around the corner and our hunts are filling up!

(and hopefully cooler weather!)

Sign-up today for one or both COM dove hunts!

September 7-8 Breckenridge, TX September 28-29 Goldthwaite, TX

- 9/7-9/8 hunt is \$100 per gun for two half days, and adults may hunt too. Youth and adult may share a gun. Kids 9-12 years old are \$50 per gun for two half days. (\$50 nonrefundable deposit required to reserve your spot. Full payment due one week before hunt.)
- 9/28-9/29 hunt is \$100 per adult/youth pair for two half days. (Same deposit as above.)
- May choose to hunt any combination of Friday evening, Saturday morning and/or Saturday evening. For first hunt the price increases to \$150 per gun to hunt all 3 times (\$75 per gun for 9-12 year olds.) For second hunt price per adult/youth pair increases to \$150 to hunt all 3 times.
- Please note on application which days/times you plan to hunt.
- All meals and lodging are at your own expense. The only exception is for the hunt on 9/28-9/29, the first 4 people to register may stay at the lodge on the ranch for no extra cost.
- For the 9/7-9/8 hunt, if we have 10 people who want to stay at the ranch, we get a discounted rate of \$60 per night per person for the lodge. Fewer than 10 is \$75 per night. We also have rooms reserved (under Danny Souder) at the Best Western Plus Hotel in Graham (closest that was still

- available). Please note on application if you will stay there. Cost is approximately \$134/night. Hotel number is (866) 599-6674.
- For the 9/28-9/29 hunt, we have reserved rooms (under Danny Souder) at the Relax Inn in Goldthwaite. Please note on application if you will stay there. Cost is approximately \$50/night. Hotel number is (844) 492-5948. We MUST know by September 10 if you will be staying here.
- Variable fees are due to different costs charged by the ranch.





To sign-up go to www.smpglobal.org (follow Outdoor Ministry links) for application, insurance waiver, and payment information. We MUST have a completed application and waiver on file for you prior to the hunt. Thank you.

Additional details such as driving directions and suggested hunting gear/supplies will be provided to hunters prior to the event.


