### Outdoor Adventures Education Educator of the Year 2013

Bill's program has grown tremendously the past few years due to his leadership and compassion for his students. The Coppell Outdoor Adventures students travel to Elm Fork Shooting Range each semester and enjoy a full day of shooting. Coppell High School also has a new Competitive Shotgun team starting this year. Mr. Parker also includes indoor rock climbing, fire craft building and survival skills exercises with his classes. The DEF Board of Trustees wants to say thank you very much for all you do for your students and sharing the great outdoors with them.

#### **New Boater Education Deferral**

Under the new boater education deferral rule, a person 18 years or older may purchase a one-time 15-day deferral for \$10 to operate a vessel on Texas waters. This deferral gives vacationers and new boater operators an opportunity to use a watercraft before they take a boating safety class. Fifteen days was selected because it matches the days required for a new boat owner to register their boat, and it also covers a two week vacation period. The deferral may be purchased on-line and through the point-of-sale system, just like purchasing a hunting license.

The TPWD was required by the past legislative session to put this deferral rule in place. This could spark some good class discussion regarding the requirement of rules like this!

#### Who puts on these camps?



The Texas Brigades is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization. The camps are put together by a dedicated group of volunteers from various government agencies, non-profit organizations,

businesses, and individuals interested in teaching youth about the great outdoors.
