### **DEF Mission Statement**

It is the mission of the Dallas Ecological Foundation to Empower today's youth with the awareness to appreciate and embrace all outdoor and wildlife conservation skills thus enabling them to be educated, accomplished, and respectful stewards of the world's natural resources and to impart them with the passion to pass their knowledge to future generations.

The goal of the DEF Outdoor Adventures' program is to provide and expose students and their parents through a hands on, real world curriculum;

- An appreciation of the outdoors
- The desire for conservation of wildlife and habitat
- An improved self-worth and well being

Outdoor Adventures is a Texas Education Agency approved Physical Education curriculum currently being offered in over 170 schools in Texas and six (6) other states. Current enrollment is 17,000 students.

#### Official Raffle Rules

a. Prize: Hunt description: Adult and Youth, 5 day 2 x 1 guided black bear hunt, spring 2014 or spring 2015 from outfitter's available dates.

Transportation from Outfitters base camp in Lillooet, B.C. to the bear camp, meals and lodging during the hunt, trophy prep (skinning and salting in camp), Hunting License, Bear Tag, Hunter Preservation Fund fee, and Trophy Harvest Fee for each hunter is included. Additional expenses winner must pay will include but may not be limited to: Transportation to Lillooet, B.C., Passport(s); Canadian Firearm Import Permit if bringing their rifle(s); shipping and handling costs of trophy, and gratuities for the guide and/or camp staff. Winner is responsible for all applicable federal, state and local taxes.

b. Raffle Ticket Purchase is necessary to enter or win. The purchase price has been set at \$10.00 per ticket.

- c. Eligibility: Youth hunter must be between the ages of 12 and 21 and have successfully completed a State certified Hunter's Education program. The adult must be a parent, legal guardian or have been granted written permission by the parent or legal guardian to accompany the youth hunter and be responsible for the supervision and well-being of the youth hunter.
- d. Timing: The raffle begins at 12:01 AM Central Time, 12-1-2013 and ends at 5:00 PM CT on 02-19-2014.
- e. How to enter: Entry is available online at <u>www.dallasecologicalfoundation.org</u>. Correctly complete the official entry form and submit the number of tickets desired and submit accordingly. Information is also available in the December OA Newsletter, through OA instructors or entries can be purchased from any DEF Board Trustee.
- f. Drawing: On February 20, 2014, a winner will be selected by the DEF Chairman in a random drawing from all eligible entries received. Drawing will take place during the Dallas Safari Club's Monthly Meeting. Winner does not need to be present to win. Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received.
- g. Notification: Winner will be notified at the time of drawing. Winner must correctly complete, execute and return as directed a Waiver and Release and Indemnity Agreement, Image Release (plus any additional documents required at the sole discretion of the DEF). Failure to comply with the requirements of this paragraph may result in disqualification and in the forfeiture of any rights to the prize, in which case prize may be awarded to an alternate by random drawing.
- h. Release: Winner must execute DEF Hunt and Raffle Release forms.
- i. Conditions: DEF reserves the right to modify these rules for clarification purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the Raffle. Laws: Subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited or restricted.
- j. Winner's Name: The winner's name and picture will be posted on the DEF website www.dallasecologicalfoundation.org.
