Texas Hunter Education NEW ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM The following is from Steve Hall:

NO MORE SCANTRONS or MAILING OF FORMS AND CHECKS – Everything will be electronic other than receiving your student supplies and materials in the mail in time for your courses.

Action: There will be an *online tutorial* OR scheduled training sessions OR both for you to review the new procedures in a hands-on fashion. Once it comes out, I will pass on to you the link/information so you can review how your students will register for your classes and how you "check off" each of them upon successful attendance, testing and completion of your course(s). Payments (\$5 student fees) will be made online directly to the State, so there will be no handling of fees other than the students paying you direct (\$15 fees). Stay tuned for more information. I'm excited to review the final test product today which begins the transition phase to a new registration system.

<u>TRANSITION</u>: There will be a transition period to ensure that everything is running smoothly –so PLEASE continue to <u>order</u> SCANTRONS for use until you have used the new system. Once you are comfortable, I would hold on to the blank Scantron forms for a month or two prior to discarding.


