Angler Education Supplemental Ideas

Casting and Back Yard Bass Activities (Bonnie Newcombe)

- 1. Create multiple casting challenges and obstacles.
 - a. Casting into buckets
 - b. Casting for Back Yard Bass in various situations
 - c. Casting into tires, hoops,
 - d. Casting under a board, hurdle, chair or volleyball net (simulated tree)
- 2. Divide the class into teams of 2.
- 3. Assign each group a starting point.
- 4. Each group will complete the casting assignment at each station
- 5. Award prizes for the team with the most points.

Back Yard Bass Parking Lot Tournament

Divide the class into teams of 3. Each team will compete against another team for total points or weight or timed tournament. Use the school parking lot as the lake. See diagram below. The parking space is the boat (yellow or green). All 3 anglers must stay in the boat at all times and follow all safety casting rules. Points can be deducted for stepping out of the boat. Place the back yard bass between the two boats. This activity will simulate the potential dangers when 3 people are in a boat together. Lines will get tangled, lines will break, students will break casting rules, etc. There are numerous ways to alter and change this activity. Ask you students how to modify it and create more tournaments. Have Fun!
