
National Championship Wins for Allen High School's Allen Eagle Competitive Shooting Team



Allen, Texas, July 29, 2014 — Congratulations are in order to the Allen Eagles Competitive Shooting Team for winning **THREE (3) National Championship designations** this summer at the Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) National Championships, held July 14-19 at the World Shooting and Recreational Complex in Sparta, IL, and USAYESS National Clay Target Championship, held June 28-29 at the National Shooting Complex in San Antonio, TX.

Allen Eagle Competitive Shooting Team coached by Jason Anderson, Outdoor Adventure teacher, won \$17,000 in grant prize money. Jason Anderson commented, "I am so proud of how the kids worked all year long, and then they get rewarded with a national championship. It's exciting. And I'm thankful for the administration allowing us to have another opportunity for students in Allen ISD to participate and compete through the Outdoor Adventures Program."

- 3rd Nationally High Over All (HOA) High School. Team shooters: Hunter Alford, Cecil Linke III, Warren Scott, Tyler Trinastich, Kyle Watts; HOA team score 2,019.
- 5th Nationally American Skeet High School. Team shooters: Tyler Trinastich, Warren Scott, and Hunter Alford; team score 559.
- 5th Nationally High Over All Main Event. Team shooters: Tyler Trinastich, Warren Scott, Hunter Alford, Jessica Clark, and Kyle Watts; team score 1,998.
- 8th nationally Sporting Clays . Individual shooter: Tyler Trinastich; score 188.
- 10th nationally Skeet. Individual shooter: Hunter Alford; score 91.

Preceding the National Championship in Sparta, IL was the **USAYESS Youth Clay Target National Championship** in San Antonio, TX, where AECST student athletes competed in Skeet, Trap and Sporting Clays events, winning \$10,000 in grant prizes.
